OrthoVista is not "ortho-rectification", rather it is a mosaicing tool. This program takes the digital imagery and matches color and brightness to

create a virtually seamless image. We have become quite proficient with this program, and even found it to be fun to work with.

GeoData Corp. recently completed a GIS project for Sampson County E-911. GeoData worked with Rex Owen of The Rose Group to collect new road locations using a mapping grade GPS receiver. Once the field work was completed GeoData incorporated the new data into the previously collected data and provided the county with new wall maps. The next phase consisted of geocoding all roads located in the county to help dispatch operators more quickly locate incoming calls. All data

was delivered in ArcView shape file format, as well as large format hard copy plots.
